It is in continuation of HSDMA order No. DMC-SPO-2020/14198 dated 05.01.2022 vide which guidelines of 'Mahamari Alert-Surakhsit Haryana' has been released to be implemented in the State.

Now, keeping in view the emergence of Omicron variant and persistent rise in COVID-19 cases in the State, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 22(2)(h) of the Disaster Management Act. 2005, the undersigned in my capacity as Chairperson, State Executive Committee do hereby direct to extend the guidelines of Mahamari Alert-Surakshit Haryana 'महामारी अलर्ट-सुरक्षित हरियाणा' upto 19.01.2022 (till 05:00 am) in the State of Haryana, with following additions in the guidelines released vide order dated 05.01.2022:-

- 8 more districts, viz., Sirsa, Rewari, Jind, Fatehabad, Mahendergarh, Kaithal, Bhiwani and Hisar are also included in Group 'A' districts. Hence, restrictions imposed in Group 'A' districts vide order dated 05.01.2022 shall also be imposed in these districts as well.
- II. Large congregations like all kinds of Public Meetings, Rallies, Protests, Dharnas, etc shall be prohibited in the State.

All the Deputy Commissioners shall implement the guidelines strictly. Any person violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act,2005 and other legal provisions as applicable.
